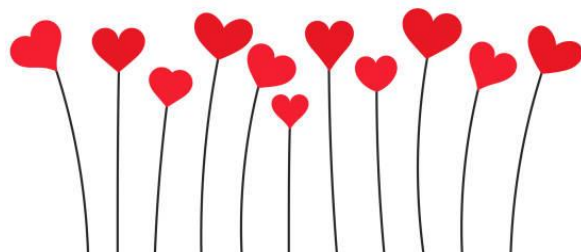

Australian Miniature Horse & Pony Registry and (Name of Show)..**AMR QLD SHOW**....(together the Suppliers) advise that participation (including passive participation) in animal handling at a show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. That handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

1 By signing this waiver I acknowledge that: 11.1 participation in animal handling is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010, and also a recreational activity for the purposes of Section 19 of the Civil Liability Act (2002); 11.2 participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me; 11.3 participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events; 11.4 animals can act in sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises; 11.5 animal showing events may be held in close proximity to loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals. 11.6 if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of weather conditions, including extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind; 11.7 insects or other animals may cause animals to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way; 11.8 there is inherent in events involving the handling of animals the risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by animals; and 11.9 I use the facilities supplied for the event entirely at my own risk; as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.

12 If I suffer injury, loss or damage (Loss) while participating in an animal handling event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any Loss I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided and/or activity I have participated in;

13 I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the event and associated activities is dangerous and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur. I acknowledge that the event and associated activities carry with them a significant risk of physical harm. I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.

14 At the time of participating in the event, I have been to any degree under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.

15 I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the event and agree that such use may result in my being excluded from the event and/or other events with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.

16 I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of the Australian Miniature Horse & Pony Registry as varied from time to time.

- This is strictly a pre-entry event. No entries after close date or on the day.
- AMR reserve the right to refuse admittance to any person/s or horse/pony as they see fit.
- AMR reserves the right to Alter, Add, Combine or Delete classes as they see fit. Judges decision is Final & no discussion will be entered into.
- Colts/Stallions must be handled by competent adults over the age of 18yrs.
- Protests must be made in writing, signed and presented to the organizing committee within 30minutes of the class being judged & accompanied by a \$50 fee which will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Protests can only be made against another competitor by a competitor in the same class/section.
- NO LIVE CHAINS. Chains must be captured.
- **Horse/Pony Ages: 1ST AUGUST**
Exhibits MUST be 1 year actual age or over to compete in Performance.
Junior: exhibits are 3yrs & under 1ST AUGUST
Senior: exhibits are 4yrs & over by 1ST AUGUST
Youth: Under 9yrs old MUST have a adult in the ring at all times.
- Overall Supreme & Reserve Performance Awards: Is total points from all events in performance. In the event of a tie breaker, Placing Points from Versatility & Hunter class will be added to determine the winner.
- Overall AMR Show Horse Award: Is total points from All Halter Classes & All events in performance including novelty. In the event of a tie breaker, Placing Points from Halter Height Class & Versatility Class will be added to determine the winner.
- Class Numbers will be slightly different from the advertised program due to the removal of any un-entered classes being removed from the schedule.
- Entrant Number Cards can be displayed on the Back, Arm or Front of jacket. No lower than hip Height. These will be provided with your Catalogue on the Saturday.

Show Rules

Miniature Horses do not exceed 34”

Small Horses should not exceed 38”

Little Horses should not exceed 42”

Foundation must not exceed 50”

Miniature Ponies should not exceed 34.25”

Small ponies should not exceed 42”

All Leads need to be Captured. NO LIVE CHAINS

Stallions/colts over 2 years of actual age will not be shown by persons under the age of 18. No youth 12 years and under may show/handle a stallion/colt at any age. With show organisers approval; youths over 12 may show colts up to 1 year old, and youths 13 and over may show colts up to 2 years of age.

Performance Classes – exhibits must be at least 1 year (actual age) to compete in any performance class.

Junior exhibits are 3 years and under at the 1st August

Senior exhibits are 4 years and over at 1st August

Youth exhibitors under 9 Years must have an adult in the ring at all times.

All Exhibitors must be a financial member to compete

Horses must be registered to compete (Can be with any society)

It is preferred that make up is kept to a minimum.

Whips are prohibited unless

Horses are to be presented clean and well groomed. Can be clipped and razored for OPEN but STOCK CLASSES must NOT BE RAZORED. Horses are to be sound and may be excused from ring if they are not.

Exhibits show at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken by AMR or its organisers, by entering you are agreeing this rule.

All equipment (including halters, leads, Bridles etc must be in good working order)

There may be random Drug testing and by entering your horse you agree to this.

Should a protest be made, it needs to be within 30 minutes of the class via a written complaint and a fee of \$50 is payable (which will be returned if the protest is found correct)

The judge can ask a competitor to leave the ring if a horse/pony is unruly.

All entries are to be pre entered.

Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry at any time.

No bullying or intimidating will be tolerated AT ALL.

If you are found to be doing so you will be asked to leave, and all entries will be forfeited. This includes side line calling out and general bad sportsmanship!
